

Alumni UK Regional Ambassadors – Open Positions 2025–2026 Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

Do I need to have the nationality of a country in the region to apply?

Yes. To be eligible, you must hold the nationality of one of the countries in the region where the position is advertised.

Do I need to reside in the region where I am applying?

Yes, you should be based in the country or region where the vacancy is open. In very exceptional cases, applicants based in the UK may also be considered if they hold the relevant nationality and can demonstrate active engagement with their region.

Can I apply to be an ambassador for a region other than my own nationality/region?

No. Applicants should only apply for positions in the region or country of their nationality.

Are ambassador positions open in all countries within each region?

Yes. Positions are open to applicants from any country within the advertised regions.

What if I am from a country in the region but currently living elsewhere (not in the UK)?

You would not be eligible, as priority is given to candidates based in their region or country. However, applicants based in the UK may be considered in very exceptional cases if they hold the relevant nationality and demonstrate active regional involvement.

Is this a paid position?

No. These are voluntary positions. While not remunerated, Ambassadors receive recognition, visibility, and access to exclusive opportunities through the Alumni UK network.

How much time will I need to commit as a Regional Ambassador?

Ambassadors are expected to dedicate a few hours each month, depending on regional activities. Commitments may include attending online meetings, supporting events, and engaging with alumni networks.

Can former Ambassadors re-apply?

Yes. Alumni who have previously served as Ambassadors are welcome to apply again, provided they meet the eligibility criteria.

What kind of support will Ambassadors receive from the British Council?

Ambassadors will receive guidance from the Alumni UK team, access to communication tools, and opportunities to collaborate with British Council staff to deliver impactful activities in their region.
