Incentives

LinkedIn Learning is an online educational platform that helps you discover and develop business, technology-related, and creative skills through expert-led course videos. 3. Trip to the UK (one winner)

The winner of this incentive will receive free flights (return, economy flights) to the United Kingdom and up to three nights' accommodation in a destination city, with arrival in a UK city of the winner's choosing.

Things to note about this prize:

- The prize must be redeemed between April 2026 and January 2027.
- The British Council will cover the costs of one economy return flight and accommodation for the winner. (Any accompanying guests are the winner's responsibility.)
- The prize value shall not exceed GBP £2,000.
- Travel insurance will not be provided, the winner must arrange for it before they travel. The
 winner must arrange and pay for all necessary visas. If a visa application is rejected, British
 Council will not reimburse any cost.
- The Alumni UK team may arrange a visit to the winner's university if the university is located
 in the city of the winner's landing or in a nearby city, subject to availability and within the
 prize period. Visits to universities outside the winner's chosen city or its near vicinity will not
 be arranged.
