Pretesting

Pretesting is an important and essential part of the test development cycle. Before new items are introduced in live tests, they go through a rigorous process that includes trialling test questions with representative samples of students so that test validation and research activities can take place.

Test variants available for pretesting

- Aptis General (for test takers above 16, A1–B2* level)
- Aptis Advanced (for test takers above 16, B1–C2 level)
- Aptis for Teachers (for test takers above 16, A1–B2* level)
- Secondary English Test (for test takers 13–16, A1–B2* level)
- Foundation English Test (for test takers above 16, A1-B1 level)

All sessions consist of Listening and Reading components.

The duration ranges from 80 minutes to 135 minutes for Listening and Reading components.

*Candidates demonstrating a level above B2 are awarded a C

Benefits of pretesting for learners:

- Informative indication of English proficiency and CEFR levels for the skills tested.
- Valuable experience in taking online tests in real exam conditions.
- Useful practice for a real test.

Benefits of pretesting for teachers:

- Receive a group report on student performance, mapped to the CEFR.
