Eligible Countries

31 July 2024

Applications to Biennials Connect grants are open to UK and international biennials/festivals and art organisations.

International biennials/festivals must be based in eligible countries. The full list of eligible countries is below.

Recipients of Official Development Assistance (ODA)*

Americas: Argentina, Brazil, Colombia, Cuba, Jamaica, Mexico, Venezuela and Peru

East Asia: The mainland of China, Indonesia, Malaysia, Philippines, Viet Nam and Thailand

Middle East and North Africa: Egypt, Lebanon, Syria, Iraq, Occupied Palestinian Territories, Jordan, Yemen, Algeria, Morocco, Libya, and Tunisia

South Asia: Bangladesh, Nepal, Sri Lanka, India** and Pakistan

Sub-Saharan Africa: Ethiopia, Ghana, Kenya, Nigeria, Rwanda, Senegal, South Africa, Tanzania, Uganda, Zambia, and Zimbabwe

Wider Europe: Albania, Armenia, Azerbaijan, Bosnia, Georgia, Kazakhstan, Kosovo, North Macedonia, Serbia, Turkey, Ukraine, and Uzbekistan

Non-ODA

Americas: Trinidad and Tobago

East Asia: Australia, Japan, New Zealand, Hong Kong, Korea, and Taiwan

European Union: France, Germany, Greece, Ireland, Italy, Poland, Romania and Spain

Middle East and North Africa: Bahrain, Saudi Arabia, United Arab Emirates, and Oman
