Project Summary The project is a three-year capacity-building programme for young civil servants, implemented by the British Council in Bosnia and Herzegovina from 1 February 2020 until 31 January 2023. The overall objective of the intervention is to assist BiH in developing a professional, de-politicised and merit-based service system by providing professional development and mobility to the next generation of civil servants who will be in charge of the EU accession process and lead change during the enlargement process. Specific objectives directly related to the overall objective described above: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. To build the professional capacity of civil servants and instil their commitment to EU-oriented civil service through their increased knowledge and understanding of the EU accession process. 2. To foster mutual connections and mobility between agents of change through facilitating an intra-BiH exchange and Western Balkans mobility programme. The expected results areas correspond to four components envisaged under the project: Component 1: Information Campaign and Selection Process Component 2: Executive Training Programmes Component 3: Intra-BiH Exchange and Western Balkans mobility programme Component 4: Networking, visibility and lessons learnt events and support of alumni activities
