

### **Creating Heroines Workshop 2021**

# Frequently Asked Questions

#### Do I have to identify as a woman to apply for this opportunity?

No. This programme is for artists who identify as female-identifying, women-identifying, queer, trans, intersex and/or non-binary

#### Do I have to pay for this opportunity?

No, this is a free workshop for selected participants through an open call application process.

#### Do you have any examples of work by previous participants?

## Does my previous work have to have gender related themes to be eligible for the workshop?

No, but you must be interested in exploring gender related themes

#### Do I need to be of a certain age for this workshop?

You will need to be 19 and above to apply for this workshop

#### Do I need to be a beginner, emerging or established artist?

This opportunity is for emerging to mid-career artists interested in developing original multimedia content focusing on gender related themes through comics, graphic novels, zines, short films and/or animation

#### Do I need to collaborate with other artists during the workshop?

There may be sessions that would involve collaboration between workshop participants.

#### I'm a live performance artist, can I apply?

No, we are looking for applicants from artists focusing on comics, graphic novels, zines, short films and/or animation

#### How do I apply for the workshop?

- Complete the online application form here
- The deadline for applications is midnight 24th February 2021. We envision to get in touch with applicants regarding an outcome during the first week of March 2021.

#### What questions can I expect in the application form:

Expect to be asked to provide the following:

- Basic background questions about yourself
- Your work portfolio with links and examples to work related to gender narratives/themes
- Your interest and expectations from the workshop

#### Is there a grant I can apply for post the workshop?

Post the workshop in March 2021, workshop participants will have an opportunity to apply for small funding to further develop their ideas through cross-border collaboration with participating artists

#### Is the grant open to non-workshop participants?

No, this is open only for selected workshop participants

#### Do I need to collaborate with other artists for the grant?

Yes, selected workshop participants will need to apply in collaboration with another workshop participant for the grant to develop a co-created piece of work

#### How will my application for the workshop be assessed?

Applications will be evaluated by the Creating Heroines panel. The panel will review the format of your work (e.g. comics/films), the alignment of your work to gender narratives/themes, and your interest in the programme. The decision of the assessment panel will be final.

#### When will I hear if I am successful?

We will endeavour to inform all successful and unsuccessful applicants by first week of March 2021
