BRITISH COUNCIL VISIT TO FRANCE, GERMANY OR SPAIN

Would you like to set up a student exchange visit to a partner school in France, Germany or Spain but don't yet have a partner school?

Give your students a truly intercultural experience by applying for a grant for travel to visit a partner school. The visit can be used to enhance curriculum teaching, improve language learning or help build soft skills.

Grants are aimed at young people from disadvantaged backgrounds. Priority will be given to applications that show the school, or the group of students involved, have significant levels of disadvantage (e.g., Pupil Premium, Opportunity Area, Index of Multiple Deprivation, Additional Needs etc). Visits do not need to include homestay, but connection and shared activities and learning with their peer group is important. For schools that don't yet have a partner school, we are arranging seminars in Spain, France, Germany in the Autumn term 2019, to allow schools to set up a partnership and plan an exchange.

France 16 - 19 October, Le Havre. We will be looking for 1 or 2 teachers and 2 or 3 pupils (years 8 or 9) from 15 schools to meet with similar from France.

Germany 28 November – 1 December, Dusseldorf We will be looking for 1 or 2 teachers and 2 or 3 pupils (years 8 or 9) from 15 schools to meet with similar from Germany.

Spain 10-14 October, Madrid. We will be looking for 1 or 2 teachers and 2 or 3 pupils (years 8 or 9) from 10 schools to meet with similar from Spain.

The outcome of the seminar will be for schools to establish their exchange partnerships and make concrete plans together for an exchange visit (with the UK leg to take place before the end of May 2020). Pupils should be ready to act as Ambassadors for the partnership and to help promote the opportunity of the exchange in their schools.

Who is eligible	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Secondary schools teachers from state schools in England (not independent schools) • Don't need to be teaching French, German or Spanish • One or two teachers per school and two or three pupils per school can attend this event

You need to	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Have the approval of your headteacher • Be committed to carrying out a student exchange • Ready to apply for up to £10,500 funding for the exchange, by 14th February 2020, with Exchange Visit with students to take place before 31st May 2020. • Have plans to include the most disadvantaged pupils (who would not normally have this opportunity) in the visit and in the partnership • Be ready to continue the partnership on the longer term.
