


From 2 July 2025, all Foundation English Test candidates who provide a valid email address during registration will be able to sign in to the Accredible platform and share their digital badge with the CEFR level on social media.

**Please note that you need to provide a valid email address before you take the test. If you provide an incorrect email address, we will not be able to edit it after you are registered for the test.**

## How to sign in to the Accredible platform?

1. To access the Accredible platform, you need to scan the QR code or follow the link at the bottom of the Candidate report.

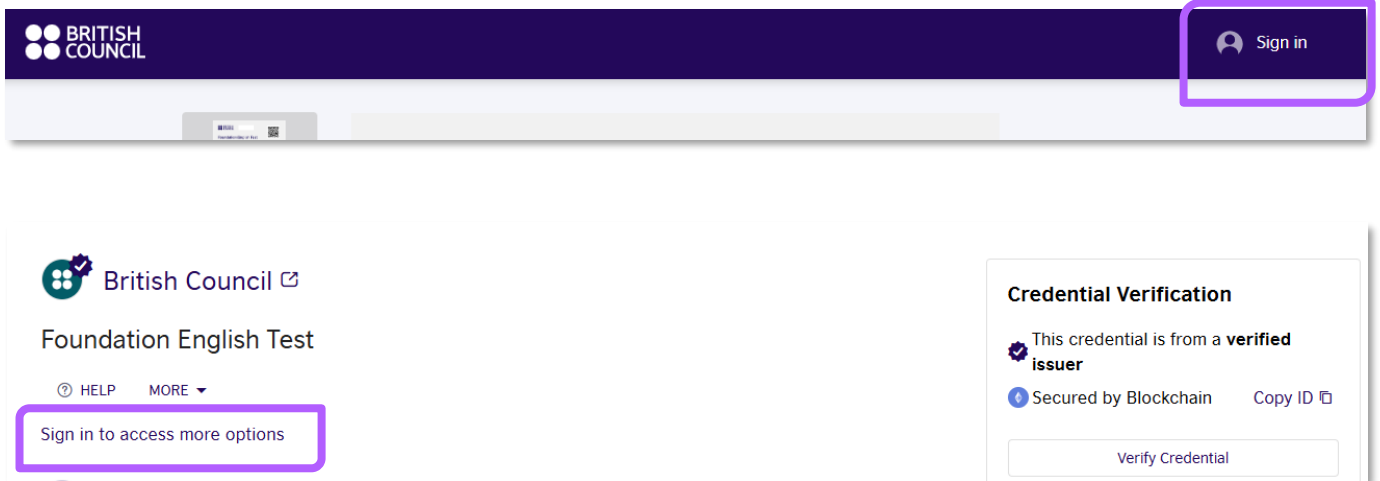

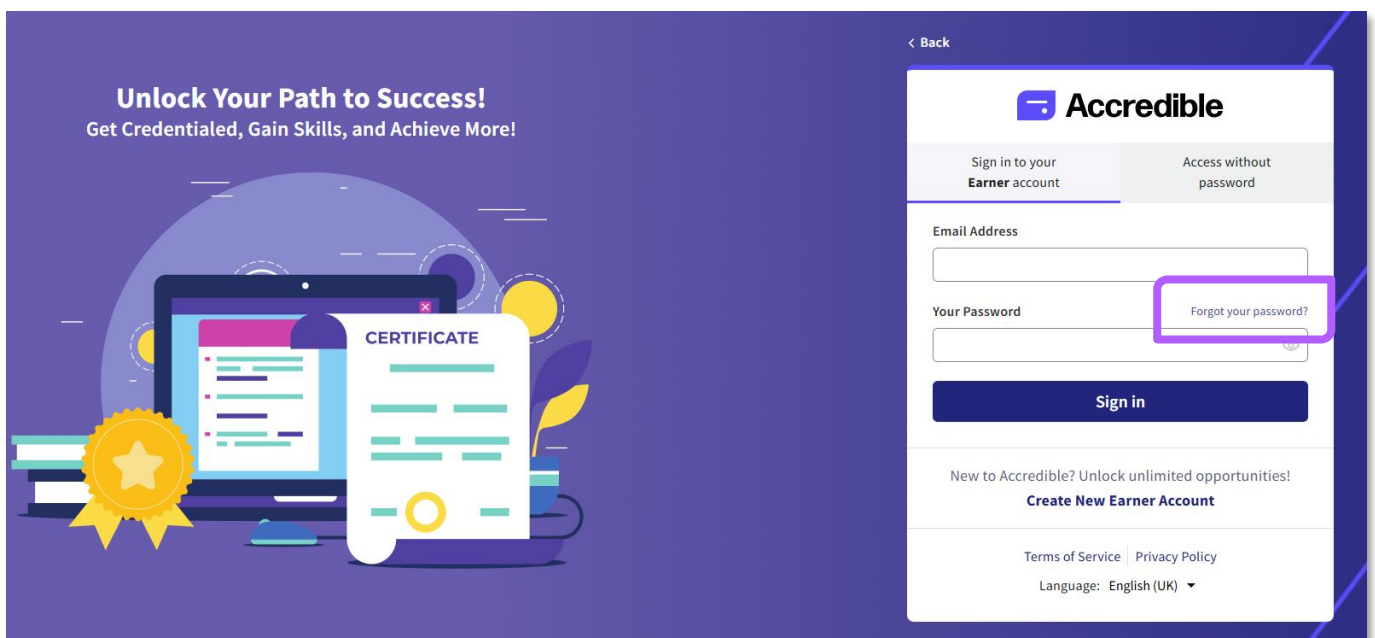

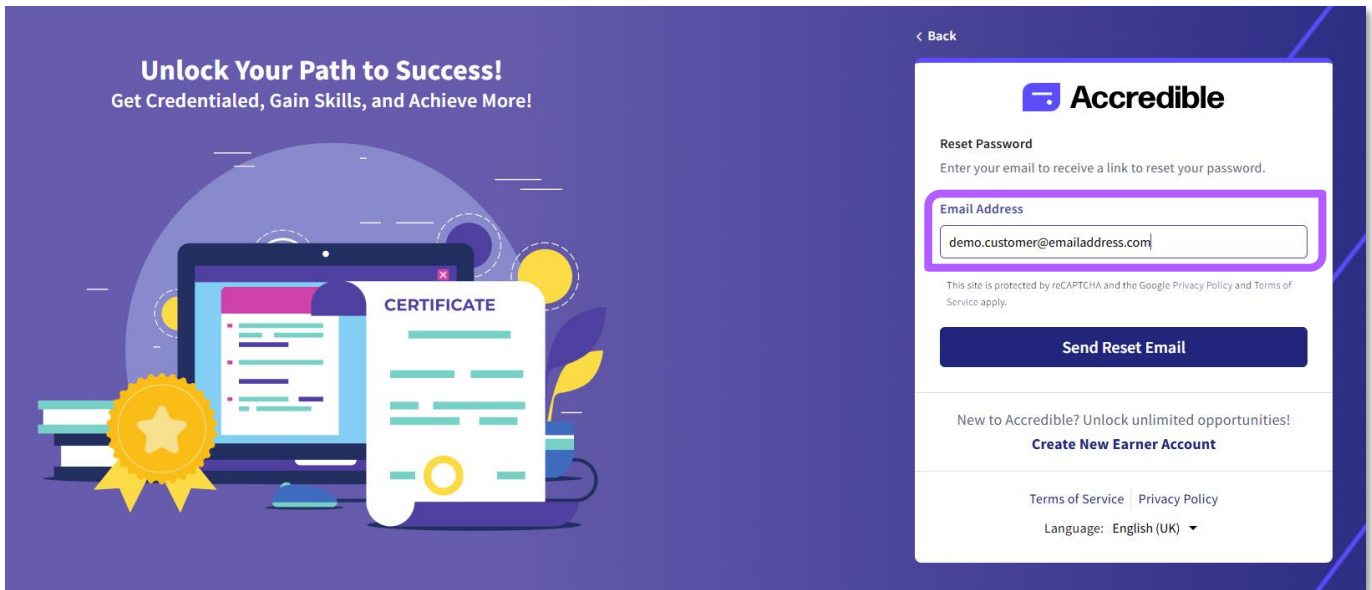
2. You will then be taken to the main Accredible page where you can view and verify your credentials.

3. To share the digital badge, you need to sign in first using the 'Sign in' button in the top right corner or the 'Sign in to access more options' link under the issuer's name.

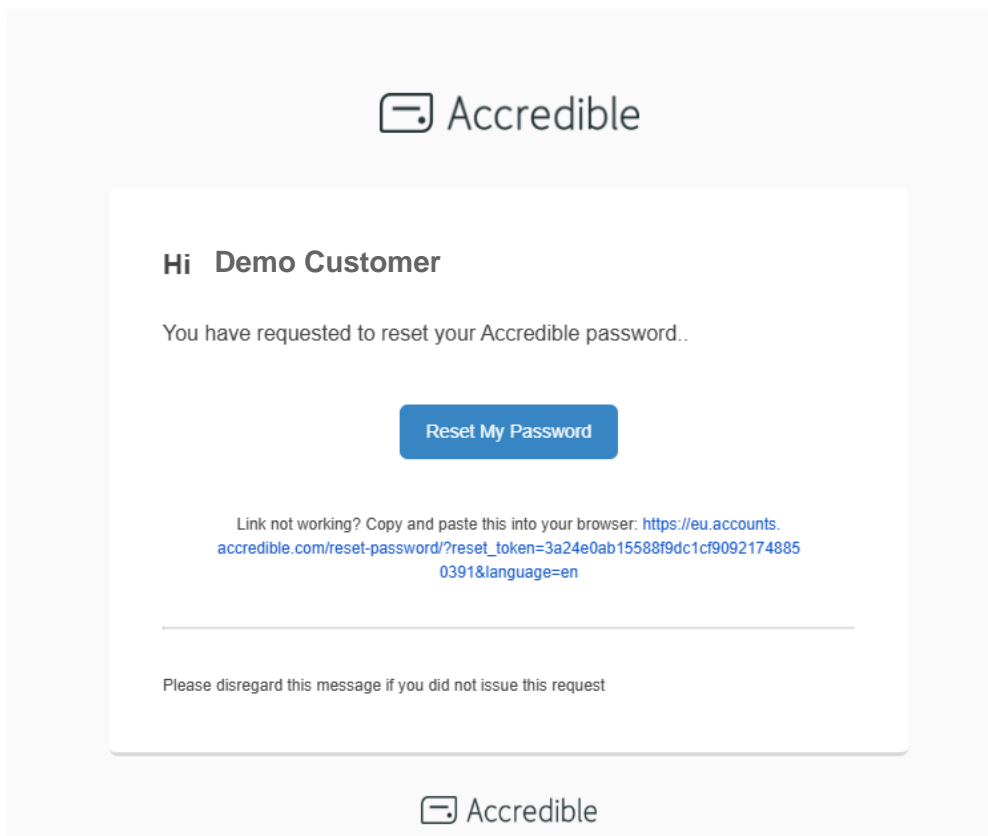


4. To log in for the first time, you will need to click on the 'Forgot your password?' option and enter the email address you have used when registering for your test.

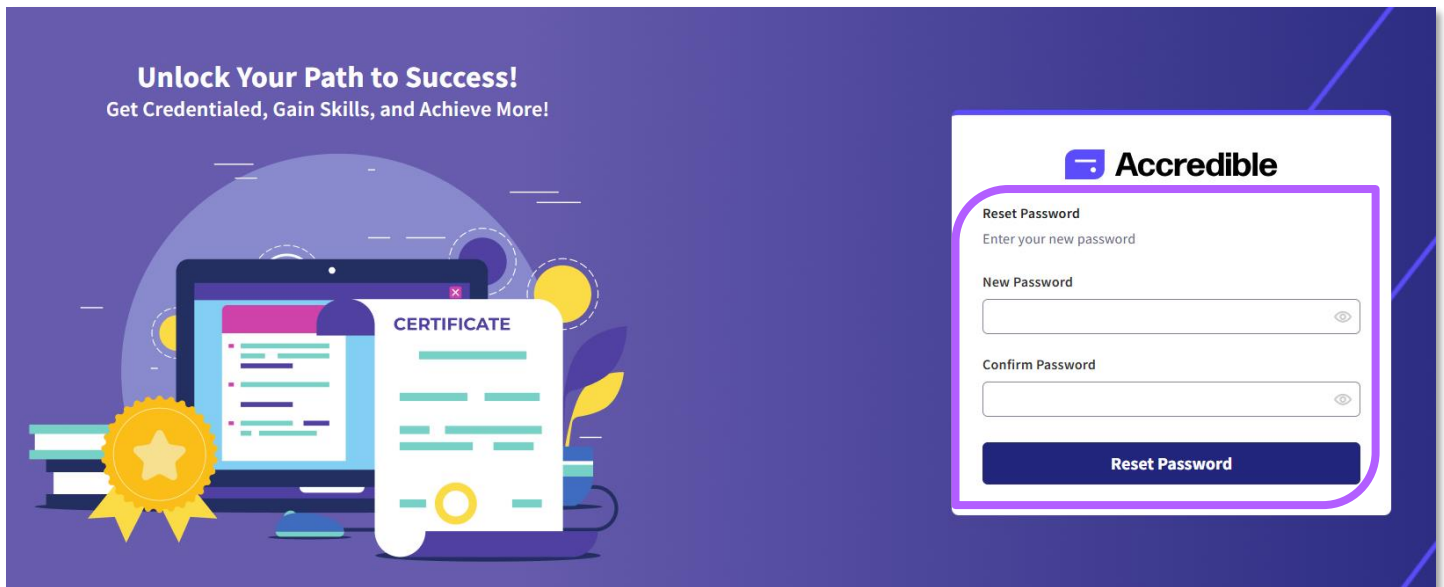




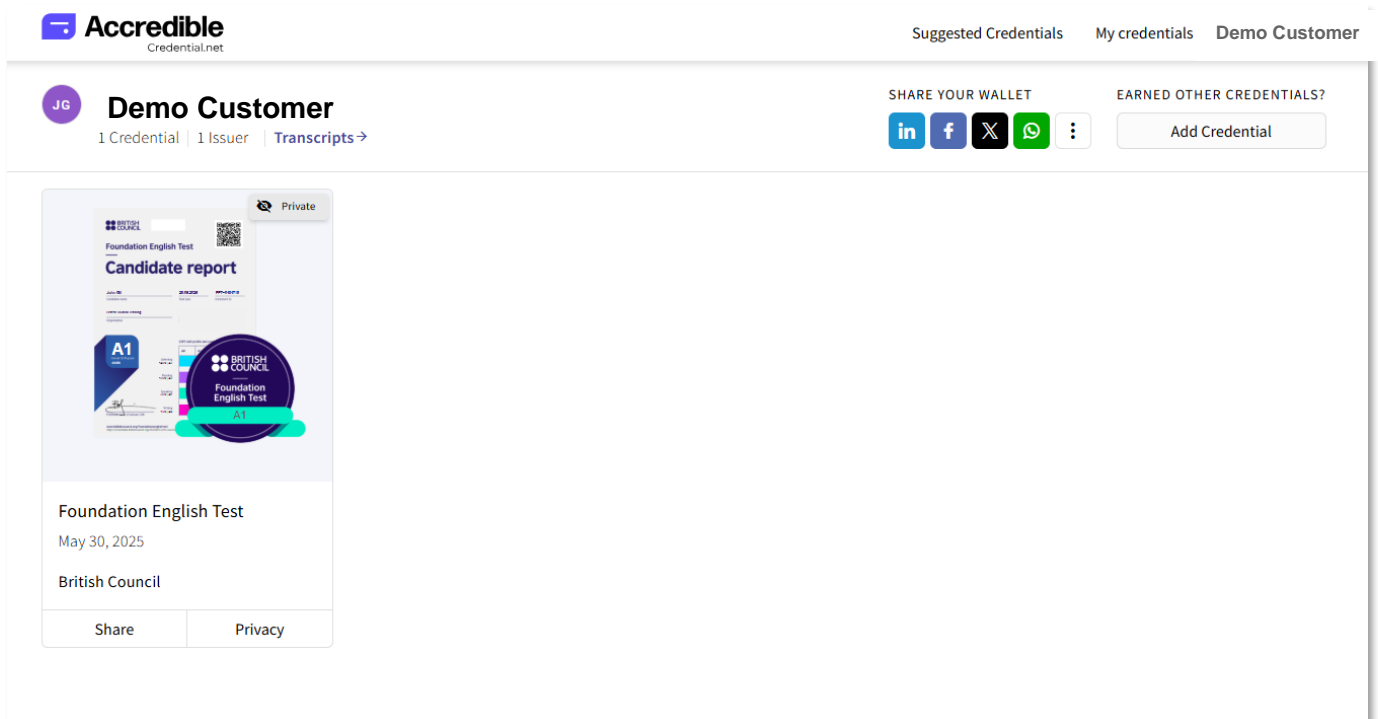
5. You will receive an email asking you to follow the link to reset your password.



- This will allow you to set up your password for your Accredible account.



- When you come back to the login page, you will be able to log in with your email and your new password. You will be able to view, share and change the privacy settings of your credentials.



8. All credentials are private by default. To share the digital badge on your social media, you will need to change the privacy settings to 'public' – the system will prompt you to do that when you click on 'Share'.
