Project Summary Lithuania has requested support from the European Commission under Regulation (EU) 2017/825 on the establishment of the Structural Reform Support Programme ("SRSP Regulation"). European Commission has agreed to provide technical support to Lithuania in the area of education and training, with the purpose of supporting their school leaders in becoming agents of change and effectively support school education reforms. The intended long-term impact of this project is to strengthen the quality of school leadership and specifically the quality of instructional leadership in schools. The project will create a two-stage training programme to support first 30 and then 300 principals across the country in becoming instructional leaders and lead the curriculum reform. In addition, the Ministry will be supported in reviewing strategic issues related to school leadership.
