



Warm Welcome Scholarship Scheme

Communications toolkit for HEPs

Introduction

- The <u>Warm Welcome Scholarship Scheme</u> seeks to support eligible individuals in the UK with links to Afghanistan to access higher education (see <u>eligibility criteria</u>).
- Scholarships will support eligible scholars to undertake undergraduate, taught master's and PhD programmes at a UK higher education provider. Scholarships are available to support both current students (<u>In-Year Scholarships</u>) and new students (<u>Full Degree</u> <u>Scholarships</u>).
- The Department for Education (DfE) is working with the British Council as the UK-wide delivery partner for the scheme.
- The scheme is co-funded with the sector, whereby participating universities must agree
 to waive tuition fees and DfE provides the funding for a maintenance stipend to scholars
 for the duration of their course.
- The Department for Education and the British Council, as part of the UK Government Warm Welcome scheme seeks the support of the HE sector to communicate details of the scheme to eligible current and potential students at UK HEPs.

Long post (e.g. for newsletter, bulletin, social media groups for current students)	Current students with links to Afghanistan may be eligible to apply for a Warm Welcome Scholarship, a new programme funded by the UK Government and delivered by the British Council. Warm Welcome In-Year Scholarships will provide financial assistance to eligible scholars currently enrolled on an undergraduate, taught master's or PhD programme at a UK higher education provider. Applications will open on 9 May and close on 20 May 2022. They will be considered in order of submission, so don't delay! Support is available for eligible UG, PGT and PhD students. Applications are open between 9-20 May via the British Council.

Long post #1 (e.g. for newsletters)	The Warm Welcome Scholarship Scheme funded by the UK Government and delivered by the British Council, provides full scholarships for higher education study in the UK and is open to applicants in the UK with links to Afghanistan. In-Year Scholarships are available for students currently enrolled on higher education courses in the UK for current academic year (2021/22).

Full Degree Scholarships are available for those who plan to begin a new course of higher education study in the UK commencing in the next academic year (courses beginning in September/October 2022).
